



## AIRO EVENTING 2026 REGULATIONS

### §1 General provisions

1. The organizer of the Airo Eventing 2026 (hereinafter referred to as the **Airo Eventing**) is the Polish Association of Hobby Horse NIP: 1251762601, REGON: 527691826, KRS: 0001086308 based in Zielonka, St. Henryka Dąbrowskiego 22/4.
2. The Airo Eventing 2026 will be held on 05.09.2026 at the sports hall in the Raszyn Sports Centre (Sportowa 30, 05-090 Raszyn).
3. Detailed information can be found on the **Airo Eventing**'s social media on Instagram (@airoeventing, @pzhh.official) and <https://www.polskizwiazekhobbyhorse.pl/> designed to register participants for the event.

### §2 Terms and conditions of participation

4. **Airo Eventing 2026** is aimed at sports enthusiasts. The event is open to people age 6 years and over.
5. The terms and condition for participation in the Airo Eventing are as follows:
  - 1) making an application via the <https://www.polskizwiazekhobbyhorse.pl/> in accordance with point 4 below,
  - 2) in the case of underage participants, presentation of a parent's or guardian's consent for the child's participation in the Airo Eventing 2026 and use of the image recorded in connection with the Competition. A model of the consent can be found in the attachment next to the registration form on the association's website. The correctly completed and signed consent must be delivered to the competition office on the day of the competition.
  - 3) In the case of adults, the presentation of consent for their participation in the Airo Eventing 2026 and the use of their image recorded in connection with the Competition. A model of the consent can be found in the attachment next to the registration form on the association's website. The correctly completed and signed consent must be delivered to the competition office on the day of the competition.
  - 4) Each underage participant must be accompanied during the Airo Eventing 2026 by an adult (of legal age), indicated in the written consent of a parent or legal guardian attached to the registration for the competition

6. Registration of a competitor should be made on the website: <https://www.polskizwiazekhobbyhorse.pl/>. up to a maximum of 6 days before the date of the competition or until the spaces are sold out, subject to paragraph 7 below. In order to make an entry, one must:
  - 1) in the application form provide the name, surname and age of the competitor,
  - 2) accept these Regulations,
  - 3) download permission to participate in the competition and permission to share images (in the case of minors, parental consent) and bring it signed to the competition office on the day of the competition.
7. Taking part in the competition implies acceptance of these Regulations.
8. The fee depends on the number of competitor's starts. The entry fee includes a ticket to the competition area. A ticket for accompanying individuals costs 20 PLN payable on site and includes entry to the hobby horse competition area.
  - Base entry fee - 85 PLN (till 14.06) or 95 PLN (after 14.06) and 10-60 PLN for each start depending on the class
  - Competitors who are members of the association can take part in the pre-registration along the international competitors

10. The organiser is not responsible for the consequences of false or unreliable data provided by the applicant.
11. Free of charge resignation from participating later than 30 days before the date of the competition is not possible. After this date, the competition fee cannot be refunded, except if a medical certificate confirming one's inability to participate in the competition is shown - in this case the Organizer will refund 50% of the paid amount.
12. The organiser reserves the limit of entries in each Competition.

### §3 Competitions

1. The right to compete in the competition is open to any competitor who has paid his/her entry fee and presented the consent of a parent or guardian to participate in the competition and has been selected or qualified for a particular competition by the Organizer.
2. The competition will be held in the following categories:
  - 50-60 cm
  - 70-90 cm
  - Grand Prix 100-110 cm + Jump Off
  - Skill-based 90-100 cm **NEW!**
  - Dressage Grand Prix Freestyle (competition with qualifications)
  - Dressage Intermediate Open (with program)

- The High Jumping (starting height is 125 cm)
3. The right to participate is open to any competitor who has paid his or her entry fee, presented the appropriate consent to participate in Airo Eventing 2026 and has been selected or qualified for the respective competition by the Organised
  4. The starting list for the competition classes will be shown on the panel at <https://livejumping.com>
  5. A competitor is obliged to arrive at the competition area no later than 10 minutes before the beginning of the competition class and to confirm their presence at the warm-up arena. Failure to appear at the warm-up arena at the indicated time means resignation from the competition, which cannot be refunded.
  6. A participant may enter the competition with their own Hobby Horse. The competitor must hold the Hobby Horse between the thighs and in at least one hand during the ride. The horse's length must be a minimum of 30 cm measured from the base of the stick to the ears (approximately an A4 paper sheet size).
  7. A second refusal to jump, i.e. disobedience on the parkour, will result in disqualification. The participant must hold the reins in both hands throughout the entire round. Releasing the reins with one or both hands for the first time results in 4 penalty points, and any further release of the reins results in elimination. Disengagement from the Hobby Horse, i.e. dropping it or falling out from between the thighs or letting go of the reins twice during one round, will result in disqualification (with the exception for High Jump, where letting go of the reins anytime over the jump, discards the score).
  8. **There is no minimum rein length specified for the round. However, at maximum tension, the reins must not be longer than the hobby horse's stick. This rule also applies to all types of elastic reins.**
  9. The organiser recommends sports footwear. Slipping of footwear from a competitor's feet during the ride will result in interruption of the ride and disqualification. The organiser recommends that the competitor has accident insurance and reserves the right to terminate the ride if the organiser considers that the continuation of the ride endangers the safety of the competitor.
  10. A medical service is available at the Airo Eventing site throughout the competition day.

#### § 4 Rules of the classes

1. The competition are based on the official rules for judging show jumping and dressage established by [International Hobbyhorse Federation](#), but might include event-specific changes. The organiser is obliged to inform the participants about basic judging points on the competition day. It is advised to contact the organizer via email [zhh.poland@gmail.com](mailto:zhh.poland@gmail.com) in case any clarification is needed.
2. The OPEN 50–60 cm and 70–90 cm Show Jumping Competitions are conducted under rule A.2.0 – Table A, against penalties and time.
3. The PZHH Grand Prix 100–110 cm is a two-round competition, extended by a final jump-off for all riders who complete the first round without faults.
4. The 90–100 cm Style Competition is judged according to the PZHH Rider Style Score Sheet,

attached to the registration form on the website.

5. The Puissance (High Jump) Class with Technical Assessment is held over a single obstacle. The starting height is 125 cm. Each clear jump is evaluated on three technical criteria, for a maximum total of 10 points:

Hand stability and rein usage – 3 points

Landing – 3 points

Overall presentation – 4 points

After each round, the obstacle height is increased for riders who have completed a clear jump and received more than 5 points in the technical assessment. The competition continues until a winner is determined.

#### §6 Awards

1. Each of the competition classes is followed by the selection of the winner, the award ceremony and the decoration ceremony.
2. In each competition the first 1 to 5 places are awarded.
3. The prizes are awarded immediately after the end of each competition. The competitor is obliged to appear at the decoration ceremony. Failure to appear at the decoration ceremony means that the right to the prize is waived by the competitor.
4. The value of each prize in kind will not exceed PLN 500.00

#### § 7 Panel of judges, complaints

1. The competition is supervised by a panel of judges appointed by the Organiser. The panel of judges will verify the order of places taken by the competitors and will decide on any eliminations or disqualifications due to misconduct or failure to meet the requirements set out in the Regulations.
2. All complaints related to the course or results of the competitions should be submitted in writing, by registered mail, to the Organizer's address specified in § 1, section 2 of the Regulations, with the annotation "Airo Eventing 2026 Competition Complaint", within the deadline of 14 days from the date of the announcement of the results of the respective competition or by email to: [airo.eventing@gmail.com](mailto:airo.eventing@gmail.com) on that date or during the Competition.
3. The complaint will be considered by the Organiser within 14 days of receipt. The competitor will be informed of the results of the complaint procedure - by registered letter in the case of a written complaint or by e-mail as a reply to a complaint sent by e-mail. The decisions of the Complaints Committee in the complaint procedure are final. Filing a complaint is a condition for pursuing claims against the Organiser.
4. Each complaint should include: a. the given name & surname of the person making the complaint together with the details of the competitor to whom the complaint relates; b. the exact return address of the person making the complaint and a telephone number; c. a detailed description and reason for the complaint.
5. Complaints will be considered by the Panel of Judges, which is also the Complaints

## § 8 Protection of personal data

1. The controller of the personal data is the Stowarzyszenie Polski Związek Hobby Horse based in Zielonka (05-220), St. Henryka Dąbrowskiego 22/4, airo.eventing@gmail.com. (Organiser).
2. Personal data of the competitors/persons making the application (hereinafter collectively as: "Participants") will be processed for the purposes, to the extent and for the period necessary for the organisation, conduct and promotion of the Competition, the selection of the winners and the collection of the prizes.
3. Participants' personal data will be used in accordance with the conditions set out in Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (OJ L 119, 4.5.2016, p. 1-88, GDPR), these Regulations.
4. The Organiser obtains the Participants' personal data (name, surname, email address and other data referred to in the Regulations) from the Participants themselves or the Participants' legal guardians.
5. Participants' personal data will not be subject to automated processing, including profiling.
6. Competitors' personal data (in terms of first and last name) may be passed on to the administrators of social networks, e.g. Facebook, YouTube, Instagram. The administrators of these social networks are personal data controllers independent of the Organiser. We encourage you to read the privacy policies adopted by these administrators.
7. The basis for the processing of personal data is Article 6(1)(b) GDPR - performance of an agreement (acceptance of the Rules and Regulations and application for participation in the Competitions constitutes conclusion of an agreement) and Article 6(1)(a) GDPR - voluntary, unequivocal, informed and specific consent of the data subject. The Organiser may also process personal data of Participants, legal guardians of underage Participants in order to establish, defend or pursue claims remaining in connection with the organised Competitions, which constitutes its legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR). In this case, the personal data will be kept for the period of limitation of claims or criminal acts resulting from the law.
8. Participants' personal data will not be transferred to third parties unless this is necessary for the performance of the Agreement, in particular to entities providing legal, accounting, archiving, courier and postal services to the Organiser.
9. Within the limits of the law, Participants have the rights to: a) access their data, b) rectify their data, c) erase their data, d) restrict the processing of their data, e) withdraw their consent to the processing of their data at any time without affecting the compliance of the processing of their personal data before its withdrawal, however, the withdrawal of consent before or during the Competition will prevent their participation. The Participant, within the limits of the law, also has the right to object to the processing of his/her personal data where the Organiser processes them for the purpose of its legitimate interest.
10. The exercise of the rights referred to above can be done by indicating your requests sent to the address of the Organiser or its designated Data Protection Officer.

11. Participants also have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if they consider that the Organiser's processing of their data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
12. The processing of personal data in connection with participation in the Competition also includes the publication of the Participant's name in any way in which the Competition is published or disseminated. The Organiser also has the right to publish the name of the Participant, on the entry list and in the results of the Competition published on the Internet and at the venue of the Competition.
13. Provision of personal data and consent to its processing is voluntary, but failure to provide such data or to consent to its processing prevents participation in the Competition.

#### § 9 Final provisions

These Regulations are public and will be made available at the Organiser's office and on the website <https://www.polskizwiazekhobbyhorse.pl/>. All information about the competition



contained in advertising material (including information posters) is for information purposes only.

1. In matters not covered by these Regulations, the provisions of Polish law, in particular the Civil Code, shall apply.
2. In the event of a breach of the Regulations by a competitor, the Organiser is entitled to exclude him/her from the competition.
3. Entitlements arising from participation in the competition may not be transferred by the competitor to a third party.
4. The persons entering the Competition and the legal guardians of the participants declare that all personal data entered by them on the entry form is complete and true.
5. Competitors/parents/legal guardians of competitors will be notified of changes by e-mail to the address indicated in the application form. Due to changes in the Regulations, competitors have the right to resign from the competition within 5 days from the date of notification of the change. Information about the resignation shall be sent to the following e-mail address: [airo.eventing@gmail.com](mailto:airo.eventing@gmail.com).
6. The organisers are not responsible for items lost during the competition.
7. The organisers shall not be liable for any injuries and accidents during the competition through the fault of the participant and for accidents and occurrences occurring during the competition.
